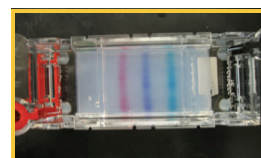
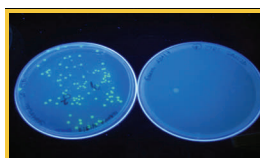


Introducing a New Chemistry Degree Option

B.S. in Chemistry with an Emphasis in Biochemistry

Changes as Compared to the 'Traditional' BS Degree

Required in the New Degree Option

Chemistry: CHE 440G; CHE 550* and CHE 552*; CHE 554
Biology: BIO 150-153; BIO 308 or BIO 315

Not Required in the New Degree Option

Chemistry: CHE 442G; CHE 522 or CHE 532/533; CHE 547
Mathematics: MA 322
Other: 2 Credits Major Field Options

*Note that the 'traditional' BS degree requires CHE 550 or CHE 552.
